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## **Learning outcomes**

By the end of this singing workshop everyone will have had the opportunity to explore sound, movement, voice placements, and, most importantly breath. In addition, participants will benefit from the following:

1. Develop your confidence and enjoyment of singing in different reggae styles
2. Learn principles of warming up the voice and breathing techniques.
3. Gain an awareness and understanding of singing with reggae rhythms and styles
4. Learn to listen and work with others, in order to achieve the focus of singing with musicians.
5. Reading and performing music
6. Have fun!

This inter-active singing workshop is full of interest, fun, activity and learning. It is suitable for teenagers and adults of all ages and abilities –. No singing experience is necessary, so absolute beginners are most welcome, as are those with more musical knowledge.
